Bias in the Mass Media: How Faith Groups Are Impacted, and How Do We Respond?

LOUIS - Interfaith Partnership/Faith Beyond Walls hosts an educational forum, “Bias in the Mass Media: How Faith Groups Are Impacted, and How Do We Respond?,” on **February 22, 2007, 7-8:30pm**, at The Ethical Society, 9001 Clayton Road.. Keynote speaker will be Linda Holtzman, Associate Professor, Communications and Journalism, Webster University. Holtzman will address “bias with intent” and “bias without intent,” and point out how to detect bias and suggest strategies to counteract media bias.
